Role Description

- In addition, playing at the special services on these particular days: Christmas Eve Crib Service and Midnight Mass, Christmas Day, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday
- Playing at other services by negotiation with the Vicar
- Playing at weddings, memorial services and funerals as available. Recommending depts where not available.
- Ensure the maintenance of the organ is carried out

Person Specification

The following are qualities and skills are required:

- Flexibility in playing and choosing a wide range of music
- Punctuality
- A desire to work collaboratively
- An understanding of the liturgy
- Commitment to the post of a church organist
- A willingness to take part in the wider musical life of St. Augustine's (eg. occasional recitals and concerts) as available

Accountability

- On a day to day basis the organist is responsible to the Vicar
- The organist is paid by the Parochial Church Council on a self-employed basis

Terms and Conditions

- Remuneration will be £3120 following the RSCM scale
- Fees: funerals services fee as agreed with the funeral director; weddings, £150
- The organist may take up to six Sundays off a year for which the fee for a deputy will be paid by the PCC
- The appointment is not at time at present a Regulated Activity, but should it become so, an Enhanced Disclosure through the DBS will be required
- The organist must work in accordance with St. Augustine's Church Safeguarding Policy
- The organist will be contracted on a self-employed basis
