

**A festival for October  
Richard Hooker, November 3rd**

Born in Heavitree in Exeter in about 1554, Richard Hooker came under the influence of John Jewel, Bishop of Salisbury, in his formative years and through that influence went up to Corpus Christi College, Oxford, where he became a fellow. He was ordained and then married, becoming a parish priest and, in 1585, Master of the Temple in London. Richard became one of the strongest advocates of the position of the Church of England and defended its 'middle way' between puritanism and roman Catholicism. Perhaps his greatest work was *Of the Laws of Ecclesiastical Polity* which he wrote as the result of engaging in controversial debates. He showed Anglicanism as rooted firmly in Scripture as well as tradition, affirming its continuity with the pre-Reformation Ecclesia Anglicana, but now both catholic and reformed. Richard became a parish priest again near Canterbury and died there on this day in the year 1600

## The Vicar's Letter

Dear friends,

There are many privileges to being a priest. It is still a joy to me to be part of people's lives—sometimes at the extremes of joy and sorrow—and to walk with people a little way along their journey of faith. Alongside my parish duties, I am involved with helping people discern if they have a vocation to the ordained ministry. This is ongoing as I am one of the team of 'directors of ordinands' in the diocese, and at the time of writing, I am seeing six people from different parishes in the Edmonton Area. Also, annually I attend a Bishops' Advisory Panel as an adviser—this is the final stage of the selection process. As someone who has seen vocations blossom in parishes before, and trained several curates, this is work I love.

Last month the clergy of the diocese met at Church House, Westminster for 'London Calling', a day for us on encouraging, supporting and discovering vocations to ordained ministry. Nationally, the numbers in training is increasing, and London plays its part in that.

I want to encourage you, first of all, to join with me in regularly praying for more priests and deacons. I also want to ask you to be open to the movement of the Spirit in your own life. Is God calling you to be a priest? If not, is there someone around you who could be prompted to think about it? In the past year we have had a member of the congregation go precisely to explore what God is calling him to do. Of course, vocation is not just about ordination, but it is a particular form of call, and for the Church to be the Church, it needs priests!
